Initial Suggestions to Work on Holiness

At this time there is no foreseeable support to meeting the request of Bishop Vann to formally grow Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration with Exposition as Bishop Vann requests but the following suggested activities will certainly begin to meet the calls of our pastors.

- Frequent Holy Mass
- Frequent Visits to the Blessed Sacrament
- Frequent Spiritual Reading
- Frequent Confession
- Prayerful Silence in the Churches before and after Holy Mass
- Daily Rosary
- Make your 3rd Degree or side-line the new 3rd Degree.

Especially encouraged is frequent visits to the Blessed Sacrament. When visiting the Blessed Sacrament at St Vincent de Paul write your Name with "K of C" on the Chapel Signin sheets.
